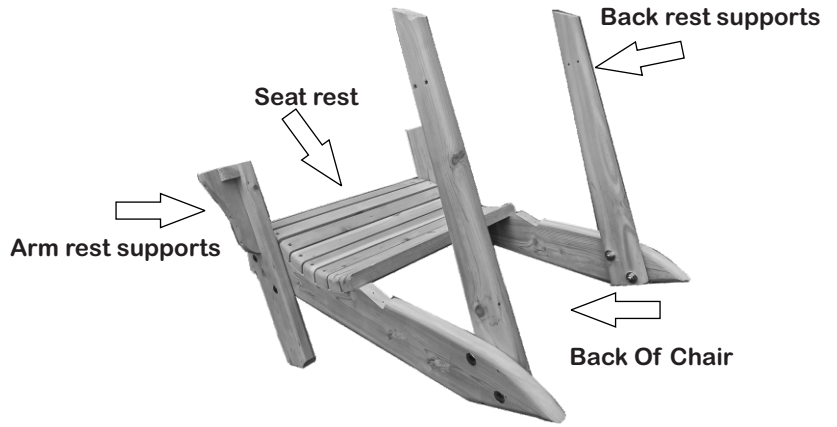
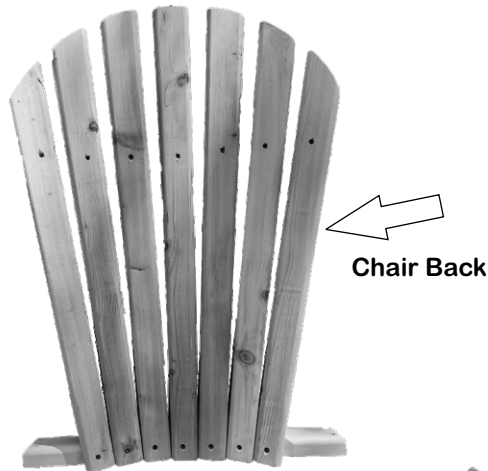

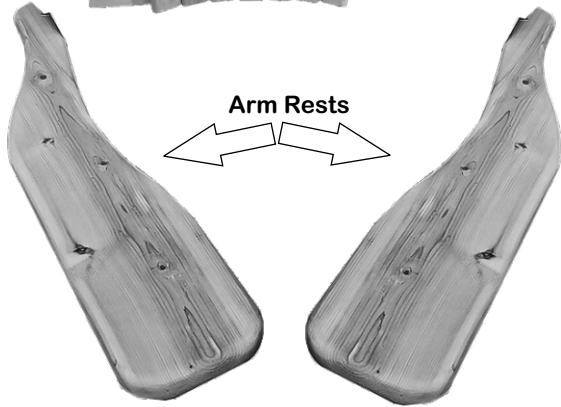
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE USE WOOD GLUE & SCREWS ON ALL TENONS & HOLES

Eight parts to assemble



5 PARTS WILL CREATE THE BASE OF THE CHAIR



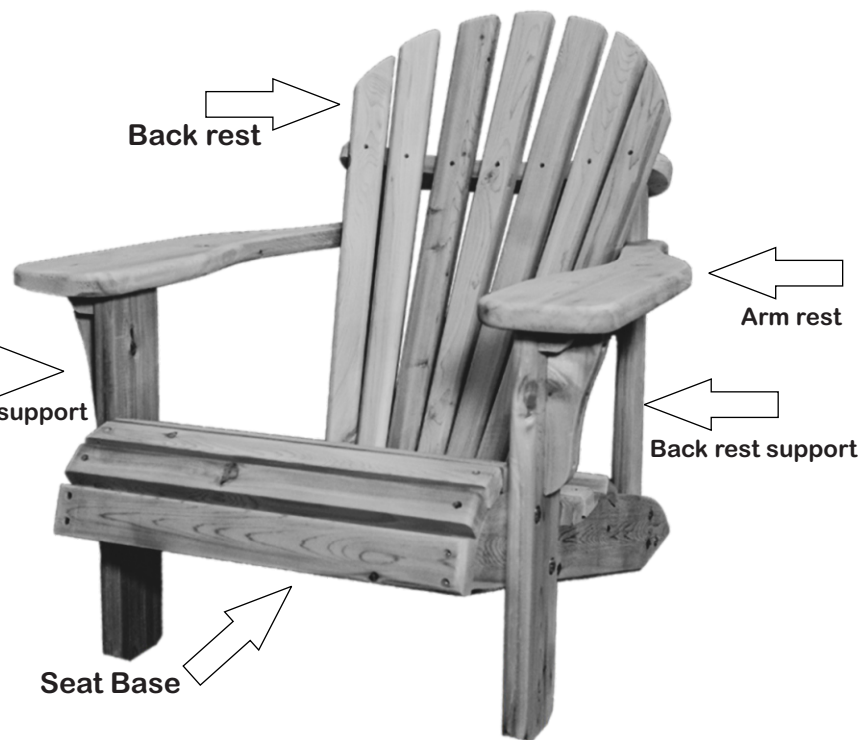
1 BOX CONTAINS:

HARDWARE:

- 8 pcs 3/8x3 carriage bolts
- 8 pcs 3/8 washers
- 8 pcs 3/8 nuts
- 18 pcs screws 2"
- 1 pcs#2 bit
- 1 bottle of glue

CHAIR COMPONENTS:

- 1 Back Rest
- 2 Arm rests
- 1 Seat base
- 2 Back rest supports
- 2 Hand rest supports



Tools required:

Square head (robertson) screwdriver



Crescent wrench



Please note that the result of checking is neither a split or a crack, In short it is an opening on the woods surface running parallel to the grain. It may be present in your cedar furniture and is a normal part of the process and can not be controlled by the manufactures or builder. It is perfectly normal and expected when purchasing cedar. Checking does not affect the structural integrity or performance of the wood itself since it does not pass through heartwood. Checking is not an indication of damgae furniture or goods and varying amount of checking is to be expected.
